Rathcoole Community Centre

My name is Tricia O' Halloran I have been involved with the operations in the Community Centre for 11 years. I have been the manager over six years and while there are a number of challenges running a busy Community Centre such as this, I find it a wholly enjoyable task. At any one time there are always a number of activities taking place every day is different.



The Community Centre is the heart of the community, where people gather for group activities, social support, public information, meetings and a variety of other purposes. The Centre is situated off Main Street just behind Scoil Chrónáin and beside the Church of the Holy Family. We have numerous activities going on in the centre on a daily basis. We cater for all ages from babies to the elderly. The Centre opens Monday- Friday from 7.45am-10pm most nights except for Fridays when we close at 7.45pm. We also open some Saturdays/Sundays to cater for events taking place e.g. birthday parties, tournaments, competitions.

There are over 60 staff working in the Community Centre. Some are on a Community Employment scheme, TUS scheme, Pobal scheme and we also have a number of volunteers. Without all the hard work and dedication from the staff and volunteers we would not be able to maintain the centre to the highest standard it is. The Community Centre receives funding from the Department of Social Protection, Pobal, South Dublin County Council and Fingal Leader Partnership.

On a daily basis we would have several hundred people pass through the doors of the Community Centre for different activities. We have two pre-schools, dance groups, karate groups, bridge clubs, music, speech & drama, youth café, baton twirlers, toddler world, kangoo jumps, zumba and so much more. You will find a list of the activities inside our newsletter. We also can cater for small parties, meetings and special events. If you have any queries please do not hesitate to

contact us in the Community Centre. You can contact us on 01-5045000. We would be delighted to help if we can. The centre also provides services such as photocopying, scanning, faxing and computer use.

Take a walk on the wild side

Four Districts Woodland Habitat

Feel like going a hike but don't want to take the car?

Feel like getting away from it all, but don't want to go far?

Well, 5 minutes from the community centre, 5 minutes from Avoca (if you live in Broadfield, 20minutes, sorry!), there is a little bit of heaven only a bit of the beaten track. Don your hiking boots, you will need them if has been raining. Throw on an old jacket, it is 'wilderness'. Enter Rathcoole Peoples Park by the 3 corner field entrance, go across the bridge, leave the path behind enter the outer field, turn right and head up along the river to the big rock and follow the trail into the wilderness or what we hope will be the 4 Districts Woodland Habitat.

There are small meadows and extensive woodland of willow, beech trees, hawthorn and other trees. Many wild flower from the lesser celadine and primroses in spring to wild rose, foxgloves and willow herbs in summer. It is inhabited by many small birds and of course our familiar rabbit and fox but also probably other creatures we never see! There is a stream which you traverse, the same one that flows through the Park.

There are well worn dirt tracks throughout and all in all it takes 45 minutes to circumnavigate the woodland. But you can also cut across the area at many points. Go have a look today. The woodland is under the ownership of South Dublin County Council and is zoned residential in the County Development Plan. Rathcoole Community Council have applied to South Dublin Council for funding to do a feasibility study to develop the natural woodland as part of a regional amenity with Rathcoole People's Park that would be unique to this part of South County Dublin. Councillors have also been approached to support this endeavour. We will keep you updated with developments.
